The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the Federal Highway (FHWA) Administration are holding a second public meeting on Tuesday, January 27, 2009 to present information and solicit public comment on the proposed improvements for Oracle Road (SR 77) from Tangerine Road to the Pinal County Line.

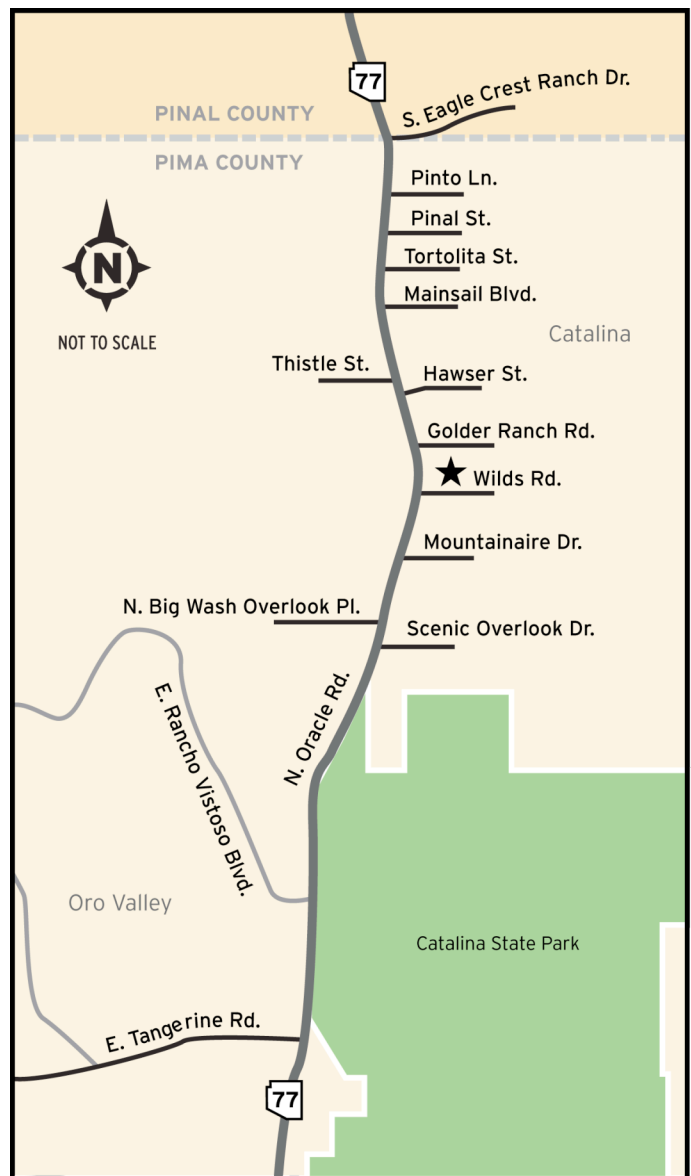
ADOT representatives will be available to answer questions and address concerns.

The proposed improvements include:

- Widening Oracle Road to six lanes by adding a new travel lane in each direction. The proposed roadway section would include three 12-foot-wide travel lanes and a 10-foot-wide shoulder in each direction for the southern end of the project.
- The northern portion of this project through the community of Catalina, the roadway section would include three 12-foot-wide travel lanes, and a 7-foot-wide shoulder in each direction.
- Raised center median with left-turn lanes.
- Rubberized asphalt for pavement.
- This project would join into the widening improvement project that is under construction from Tangerine Road to Calle Concordia (MP 77.5 to MP 82).
- The roadway construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in 2011 and continue through 2013.
